ROLES AVAILABLE 2024-25

We have one space available this incoming year which will focus on working within our Youth & Children Department. There will also be some opportunities to be involved across our other main ministry areas. This is ideal for anyone who has a desire to serve God, a heart for young people and a willingness to learn from others. Anyone from within and outside our church family is welcome to apply. The Intern will be expected to become fully active in the life of High Kirk for the duration of the scheme.

COMMITMENT

Our desire is to provide our interns with a broad and full experience of our ministry; and so the practical time commitment required will be in the region of the following:

• up to 6 week days, with 2-3 evening sessions each week, including Sundays, totalling approximately 30 hours per week.

The church is committed to ensuring that each intern receives a living allowance of £80 per week as part of the scheme. The church will also cover pre-agreed expenses incurred through your work. As well as this, we offer the opportunity to receive some practical training as part of the scheme.

The start date for the Internship will be Monday 2nd September 2024, and will run until the end of August 2025.
